In compliance with Section 183 of the Intellectual Property Code (IP Code), we respectfully apply for accreditation as a Collective Management Organization.

The Filipinas Copyright Licensing Society, Inc. (FILCOLS) is a non-stock, non-profit corporation mandated by authors, publishers, and other rightsholders in the text and image sector to collectively manage their reproduction rights (Sec. 177, IP Code).

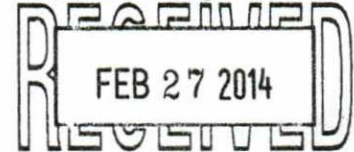
Incorporated on 8 January 2008, FILCOLS was organized by the Book Development Association of the Philippines (BDAP), Unyon ng mga Manunulat sa Pilipinas (UMPIL), the National Book Development Board (NBDB), and the Intellectual Property Office of the Philippines (IPOP HL). FILCOLS is an active member of the Brussels-based International Federation of Reproduction Rights Organizations. IFRRO is the international network of CMOs in the field of print and publishing.

FILCOLS collectively manages copyrights in literary, dramatic, scientific, educational, and artistic works. We provide easy and legal access for the secondary use of copyrighted materials for the internal and institutional use of educational institutions, businesses, and other organizations. We determine and collect licensing fees for the copying of works through photocopying and similar means; and distribute remuneration to local and foreign rightsholders.


